Kyogle

- \$156,722 for the Community Enterprise and Skills Development Centre – ‘Grove House’. Funding guaranteed under Better Regions program, opened August 2009.
- \$1.5 million in zero real interest loans to the Frank Whiddon Masonic Home to provide 19 beds at Kyogle Court and four new aged care beds at Cedars Nursing Home, Casino.
- \$698,000 in Working on Country funding for up to eight Githabul rangers to work on natural resource management in the Kyogle area over four years. Announced September 2009.
- \$917,200 for indigenous workers to improve walking tracks in Green Cauldron National Landscape in Kyogle, Murwillumbah and Lismore.
